Sea Bright Rising Announces Residential Rebuilding Program in Partnership with St. Bernard Project

Sea Bright Rising will partner with St. Bernard Project, a national disaster recovery nonprofit organization, formed in response to Hurricane Katrina to implement a residential rebuilding program in the community of Sea Bright, New Jersey. The program will serve residents who own homes but lack the financial means necessary to rebuild on their own.

Sea Bright Rising has been active in recovery efforts since Sandy raising more than \$1,200,000. Prior to partnership with St. Bernard Project, Sea Bright Rising has focused on three main areas of recovery: assisting residents, the business community, and community infrastructure. The residential rebuilding program will serve residents still waiting to return home after Hurricane Sandy in the communities of Sea Bright, Highlands, and Rumson, NJ.

This strategic partnership will allow Sea Bright Rising to utilize SBP's proven model and provide clear, prompt, and efficient paths to recovery for homeowners who have been displaced for more than a year. Sea Bright Rising and St. Bernard Project are committed to the long term recovery of Sea Bright and the surrounding areas.

St. Bernard Project will share its nine years of experience in disaster recovery and lessons learned through rebuilding in the communities of New Orleans, Louisiana, Joplin, Missouri, and Staten Island and Rockaway, New York. SBP is excited to expand NY regional operations to New Jersey and looks forward to working with local residents to rebuild their homes and their lives.
